

# DATA COORDINATOR AND ANALYST

## The Opportunity

The Data Coordinator and Analyst will be responsible for creating, maintaining, organizing, analyzing, and reporting data and metrics from various departments in the field and the National Office. This person will help provide key information and insights to various departments to help facilitate better decision making. They will work closely with various leaders across the country. This is a regular full-time MPD position based at the SPO National Office in Mendota Heights, MN.

### Mission Reporting and Analytics (50%)

- Responsible for managing mission analytics, including working with mission leadership to
  determine data needs and adjust where necessary, sending reports and surveys to staff,
  analyzing and interpreting data, and providing reports for mission leadership and the
  Executive Team, and Board of Directors, and Regional Advisory boards
- Be available to the Executive Team and other senior/national leaders to collect and analyze data to improve the effectiveness of our mission and the efficient use of our resources.
- Steward the national CREW/ROSTER moves management system.

#### MPD Data and Process Management (20%)

- Ideate and implement improvements and changes needed in DonorElf, Gift Operations,
   Smartsheet, and Onboarding/Offboarding processes (etc).
- Steward the MPD Team's Smartsheet Dashboards, spreadsheets, and data analytics and provide reports and analysis as needed.

#### Other Data Coordination and Analysis (20%)

- Steward the Recruiting Team's dashboards and trackers to ensure that we are moving constituents through the recruiting, placement, and promotion processes.
- Provide reports to the Development team as needed
- Serve other departments as needed.

#### Personal Mission Partner Development (10%)

- Reach and maintain MPD vision driven goal.
- Cultivate support team during the year through regular communication.
